Parade: 1:00 pm

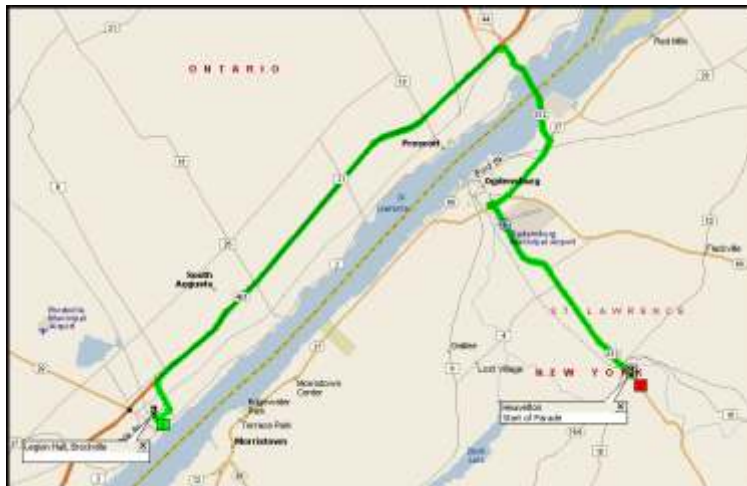


Driving Directions:

Cross the Johnstown-Ogdensburg International Bridge. Turn right and proceed west on State Route 37 West. After passing the “Golden Dome” in Ogdensburg, turn right on Route 812 South (see aerial photo above) which goes directly to Heuvelton.

Take the first left as you drive into Heuvelton, on E. Washington St., and park in the school yard. We will tune up there. A bus will take us to the start of the parade. The parade comes back through town to the school, so we finish near our cars.

Total distance: 46 km.



Parade Route:

Starting at the top of the hill south of town, the parade goes down the hill into town, up the hill, and turn right. The parade ends in front of the school.

Total distance: 1.1 km.

Après Parade:

We usually refresh ourselves immediately after the parade in Doug’s Tavern, 36 State St.; a generous Heuvelton citizen, Gary Duvall, picks up the tab..... He raises money to pay our fee through a summer golf tournament.
